Camping

Idea: Sit upons (cushion, grocery bag, duct tape)

Prep & Packing

Packing list, send to girls & moms; have older girls pack themselves, younger girls to pack with parent oversight

No electronics rule

No food or snacks or special treats

Be prepared for all weather, bring rainboots or water proof shoes, clothes will get wet and dirty, plan for layers, wool and other fabrics, proper raingear

Knit or wool cap for sleeping

Sleep with next day clothes in the bottom of sleeping bag to warm them up.

Leader bring extra clothes, sleeping bags, blankets, equipment, feminine products, etc.

Camping contract for girls to sign.

Troop First Aid kit, medications does not stay with the girls, parents need to sign a form

Have girls practice rolling sleeping bag

Nighttime wetting handled discreetly, keep pullups in sleeping bag

Keep medical forms on you, even for adults

Food

Keep it simple

Some bagged meals for travel there

Breakfast – hardboiled egg, cheese, and toast

Dutch oven recipes

Scramble eggs boiled in a bag
